Centrifuge Coordinator: Please read all information in this packet, so that you can be aware of all forms, rules and regulations. There are some changes this year.

The following forms for the church to complete for drivers only:

- *Acknowledgement and Assurance Form* – This form must be filled in by any person responsible for transporting any of your group to and from Bambi Lake. Please return this form to Bambi Lake before you take students to camp. Late forms may be taken to Bambi and submitted at the time of registration.

Reservations

- All fees apply to all persons attending Centrifuge, i.e., youth and adult sponsors.
- Confirmation fee must be in by April 24, 2009: \$110.00 for each person attending Centrifuge. **Send payment to Bambi Lake Retreat and Conference Center** payable to Baptist State Convention of Michigan.
- Final cost due at Bambi Lake: \$110.00 per person (making total cost \$240.00). Please submit one check for your group payable to Baptist State Convention of Michigan.

The response to Centrifuge week at Bambi Lake each year is phenomenal. Due to limited space it is very important that you encourage youth to realize they have made a commitment to attend Centrifuge. If they are not going, you need to cancel their reservation as soon as possible by contacting Bambi Lake at 989-275-5844. Reservation deposits (\$20) are refundable.

[Effective January 1, 2004, deposit for all overnight events at Bambi Lake will be \$20 per person. The deposit will be fully refundable to the payer if notice of cancellation is received at Bambi Lake by the 14th calendar day before the event begins. After 14 days it shall be non-refundable (except under emergency circumstances, described below), but fully transferable to the deposit of another person attending the event. It may not be used to pay any portion of the balance due for any attendee. "Emergency circumstances" are the death or hospitalization of the attendee or a member of his/her immediate family.]

The confirmation fee of \$110 (due April 24, 2009) is refundable as follows: those canceling 15-30 days prior will receive a 50% refund and those canceling less than 15 days prior will receive no refund. Reservations are transferable, but only to another camper from the same church (preferably of the same gender). There are no discounts for more than one person from the same family. However, there are full and partial **scholarships available** for SBC churches in Michigan through our State Missions Offering for anyone attending Centrifuge.

Students (Youth)

Youth must be 12 years old and have completed the 6th grade. The age limit is 18 years old or those who have just graduated from high school. We cannot accept those who do not meet these qualifications. All youth must complete a health card. All medications must be checked in to the nurse at the Check-In desk, with a list and schedule of times when medication must be taken.

Students should bring:

- Bed linens and towels and extra towels for swimming. **LINENS & TOWELS ARE NOT PROVIDED**
- Bible, paper and pencils, completed registration card and health card.
- Money for a missions offering, refreshments, and souvenirs. A large amount of money is not necessary.
- Casual clothes and a one-piece swimsuit (no short shorts, bikinis, or midriiffs should be brought). Blue jeans are acceptable. Appropriate attire is expected in worship services. If youth wish to participate in possible on-stage opportunities, they will need to bring long pants or a long skirt for the performance.
- Personal articles such as toothbrush, shampoo, etc.
- Camera
- A good attitude and expectations of having a wonderful week
- An openness to what God will do in their lives this week.

Students should *not* bring:

- Cell phones.
- MP3 players, CD players, radios, etc.
- Tobacco, alcohol, non-prescription drugs, fireworks, firearms or any kind of a weapon. Any adult sponsor or youth caught with these will be sent home at the church's expense.
- Expensive items you would not want to lose.

Adult Sponsors and Drivers

Centrifuge requires one (1) adult male every seven (7) boys and one (1) adult female for every seven (7) girls in attendance. Each church **must** send at least one (1) sponsor. Add an additional sponsor for every additional seven (7) students. If you have a problem finding sponsors, let us know and we will give you a list of churches that may be able to help care for your youth. You will be responsible for contacting that church and making those arrangements. We can no longer assign youth to sponsors from other churches.

Rules regarding Centrifuge for adult sponsors must be adhered to.

- All sponsors must be 19-years-old or older.
- **All sponsors are required to receive camp training & orientation.** The State of Michigan Department of Social Services requires three hours of sponsor training using the *Youth Camps & Retreats Policy and Procedures Manual*. A training DVD will be mailed to each church. If you do not receive the training DVD soon after you register, please contact Bob Wood at the BSCM office, 810-714-1907 or bob@bscm.org. **Is is mandatory that all sponsors receive this training.**
- All sponsors must complete the following set of forms:
 - Three form to be completed by each adult sponsor and sent to the BSCM office (**Centrifuge, BSCM, 8420 Runyan Lake Rd, Fenton, MI 48430**) by May 22, 2009:
 - 1) *Application for Children's/Youth Ministry*
 - 2) *Release of Employment Records and Information.*
 - 3) *Authorization and Release for Criminal Background Records Check and Central Registry Check*
 - Two forms to be completed by each sponsor and camper and taken with them to Bambi Lake:
 - 1) *Bambi Lake Health Certificate*
 - 2) *Bambi Lake Photo / Video Release Form*
- **Adult sponsors are trained and given assignments on Tuesday for the full week; therefore, they should stay the entire week. Latecomers would not know how to perform those duties.** There will

an hour of training on safety regulations Tuesday morning at Bambi Lake. All sponsors are to attend this meeting. Arrangements will be made to care for your youth.

- *Acknowledgement and Assurance Form* -- This form must be filled in by any person responsible for transporting any of your group to Bambi Lake. Return this form when you submit your list of names and registration money to the Centrifuge Office, or no later than registration day at Bambi Lake.
- The Centrifuge Coordinator and church leaders are responsible for preparing their sponsors. Sponsors should be growing Christians. They will have responsibility for devotional times. They should be able to give some spiritual guidance and will have opportunity for counseling boys and girls about God's will in their lives.

Check-in and Check-out

Check-in will begin at the Lodge at 2:00 p.m. to allow plenty of time for room assignments and waterfront tests. Rooms will be assigned by Bambi Lake Conference Center. Please plan to register with Centrifuge between 2:00 & 4:00 p.m. on Monday and provide the following for your group.

- One check for your group, payable to Baptist State Convention of Michigan
- Your name, church name, and names of your adult sponsors
- Total number of people registering for Centrifuge
 - * Separate list of male/female, listed by grade entering in the fall
 - * T-shirt sizes (please do not oversize shirts)
- Pre-registration cards must be turned in at this time.
- You will receive important information regarding T-shirts and daily schedule.

Only the Group Coordinator may register the group. Others will stay in a designated area or one of your sponsors who is familiar with Bambi Lake may acquaint first time attendees with the location of the auditorium, dining room, etc. At check-in, you will receive the schedule for the week and information on T-shirts.

After check-in, the youth will go to the camp health officer to turn in health cards. Youth will also be expected to turn in all medication, with schedule of dosage, to the nurse at this time. After this, the youth will go to the waterfront area for swim tests. A Lifeguard will be on duty during water activities. Every person will be given a colored tag indicating level of swimming ability before they can participate in any water sports activity. The tags will be the entrance tickets to dinner, which will begin at 5:00 p.m.

Centrifuge closes on Friday morning before lunch with a Closing Celebration. Your group is expected to be present. Lunch will *not* be served on Friday.

State Coordinator, Nurse, & Lifeguard

There will be a Centrifuge Director on campus during the week. Any emergencies, changes in your group, problems, etc., must be reported to the Director or the Assistant Director as soon as possible.

A camp nurse will be available for the entire week. All medications must be checked in to the nurse at the check-in desk, with a list and schedule of times when medication must be taken.

A Lifeguard will be available at time of any water activities. State of Michigan law for youth camps requires that all campers be swim tested before any water activities are done. Everyone in camp must have a colored tag.

Health Certificate Cards

You will receive health certificate cards from Bambi Lake. You must turn in a completed card for each student and sponsor when you register at Bambi Lake.

(Because Bambi is always crowded during Centrifuge week, Bambi staff has asked that no family, friends or visitors "drop in.") *Only registered Centrifuge campers will be permitted to use the campground during Centrifuge.*
2. Bambi is a Christian camp. Decent dress code is in order, especially for worship services. Girls should especially be reminded that no midriffs, low cut dresses (front or back) or strapless dresses of any kind should be worn at Bambi. It is sponsor's responsibility to see that your youth are dressed appropriately.
3. Sponsors will be responsible to maintain curfew. No one is permitted to leave Bambi at night. All participants must be in their rooms by 11:00 p.m. Everybody must observe lights out at 11:30 p.m. for the benefit of all campers and staff. Late night carousing is not permitted. Sponsors will be responsible to maintain curfew and are not to leave their youth *unattended*.
4. Room occupants will pay for damage done to rooms or the church will be billed. Participants failing to obey camp rules will be removed from camp.

Centrifuge closes on Saturday morning with a Closing Celebration. Youth are expected to stay for the duration of the camp. Lunch **will not** be served on Saturday.

The Executive Board of the Baptist State Convention of Michigan has approved certain policies that must be followed while at Bambi.

1. No one is to leave Bambi unless permission is given by the Bambi Lake Conference Center Director. Calls and visitors are discouraged. Only calls for emergencies should be made, in or out. Visitors who have meals in the cafeteria must pay for those meals. There will be no space for overnight visitors. Only registered Centrifuge campers will be permitted to use the campground during Centrifuge.
2. Bambi Lake is a Christian camp. Decent dress code is in order, especially for worship services. No shorts. Girls: No midriffs, low cut dresses (front or back) and no strapless dresses of any kind should be brought to Bambi. Blue jeans are acceptable at any time.
3. Lights out must be observed for the benefit of all campers. Late night carousing is not permitted. Sponsors will be responsible to maintain curfew. No one is permitted to leave Bambi at night.
4. Room occupants will pay for damage done to rooms or the church will be billed. Participants failing to obey camp rules will be removed from camp.
